### **NURSING ASSISTANT TRAINING PROGRAM**

#### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

All persons must submit a completed admission application. Applicants must be at least 17 years of age or older and/or at least a junior in high school and obtain 8<sup>th</sup> grade levels for reading, mathematics and language. In addition, applicants must be physically capable of lifting over 50 pounds. Additional documentation may be requested to clarify or verify information provided by applicants for admission to Regional Center for Border Health, Inc. Job Training Center. A criminal background check is required prior to enrolling a student into the Nursing Assistant Training Program.

#### **Program Description**

<b>PROGRAM NAME</b>	Nursing Assistant Training Program
<b>PROGRAM LENGTH</b>	6 weeks
<b>PROGRAM HOURS</b>	65 Classroom Hours 20 Laboratory Hours 65 Clinical Hours  <b>Total 150 Hours</b>
<b>PROGRAM DESCRIPTION</b>	The Nursing Assistant Training Program is a 6-week training program designed to prepare students with the necessary skills to pass the Nursing Assistant Certification exam and practice as beginning nursing assistants.
<b>PROGRAM GOAL</b>	The Nursing Assistant Training Program goal is to prepare students to apply client self-care concepts and basic procedures relative to fundamentals of nursing, communication, nutrition, anatomy and physiology, medical terminology, legal and ethical issues and medical terminology.

#### **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

To graduate from Regional Center for Border Health, Inc. Job Training Center, a student must:

- Pass all required course of study courses and laboratory/clinical training;
- File a completed application for Graduation form;

- Clear any indebtedness to the college before certificate is awarded

## CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

To obtain certification through the Arizona State Board of Nursing, students must:

- Complete an approved nursing assistant training program;
- Complete an application for Certified Nursing Assistant Examination;
- Pass the written and manual tests;
- Complete fingerprint requirement
- Felony Convictions: According to A.R.S. 32-1646(B), an applicant for nursing assistant certification is not eligible for certification if the applicant has any felony convictions and has not received an absolute discharge from the sentences for all felony convictions. The absolute discharge from the sentence for all felony conviction(s) must be received 5 or more years before submitting this application. If you cannot prove that the absolute discharge date is 5 or more years, the Board will notify you that you do not meet the requirements for certification.
- Pay fees (optional)
- Effective January 1, 2008, based on Federal and State Laws, all applicants must provide evidence of citizenship and nationality.
